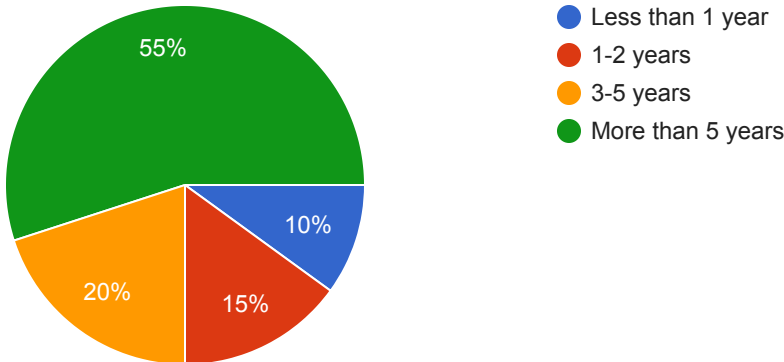

### How many years have you participated in SMART?

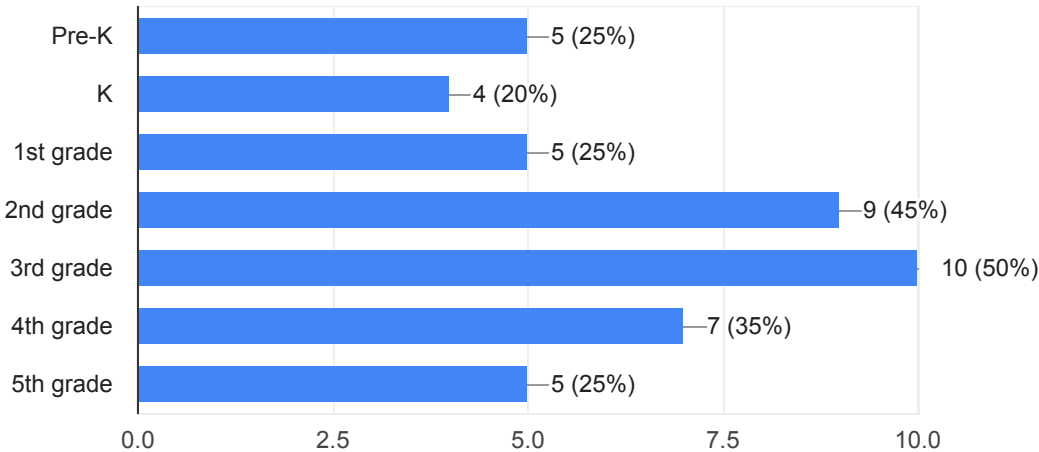

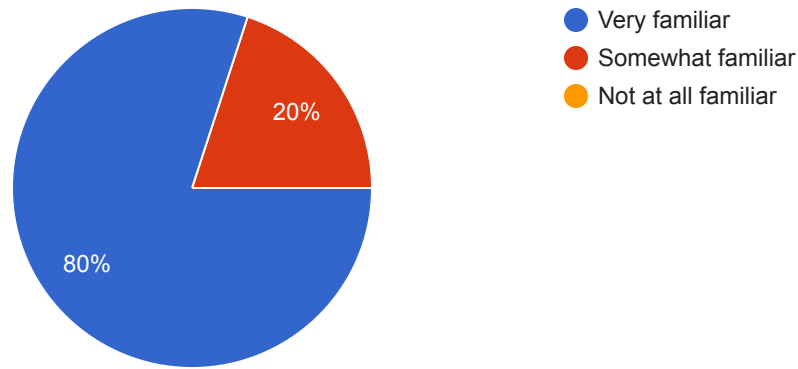

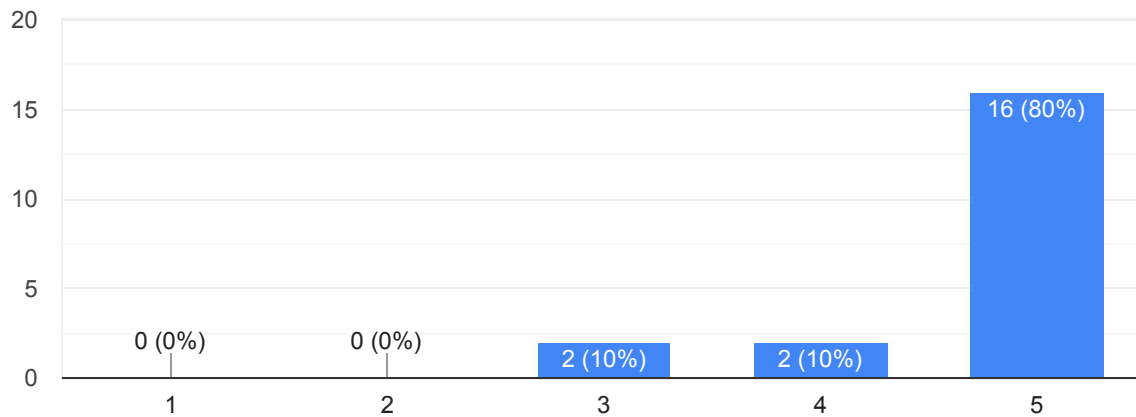

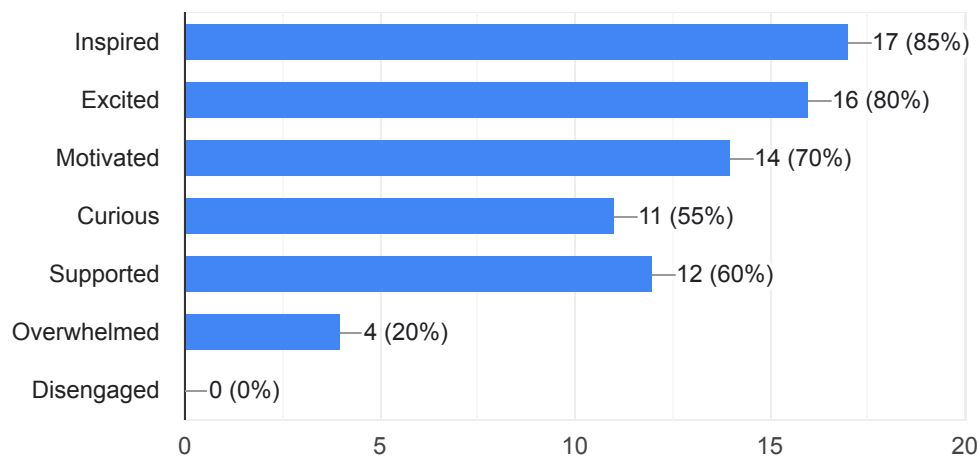

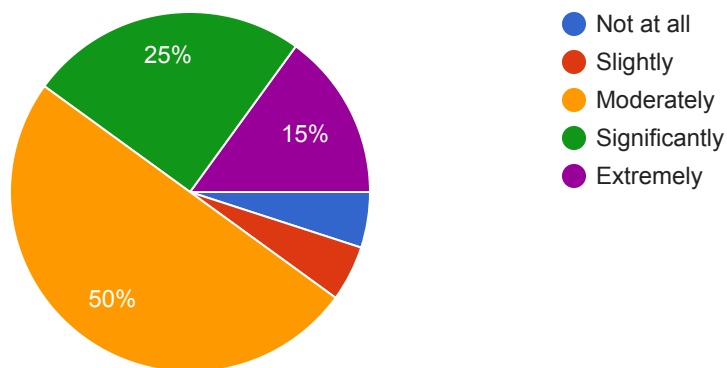

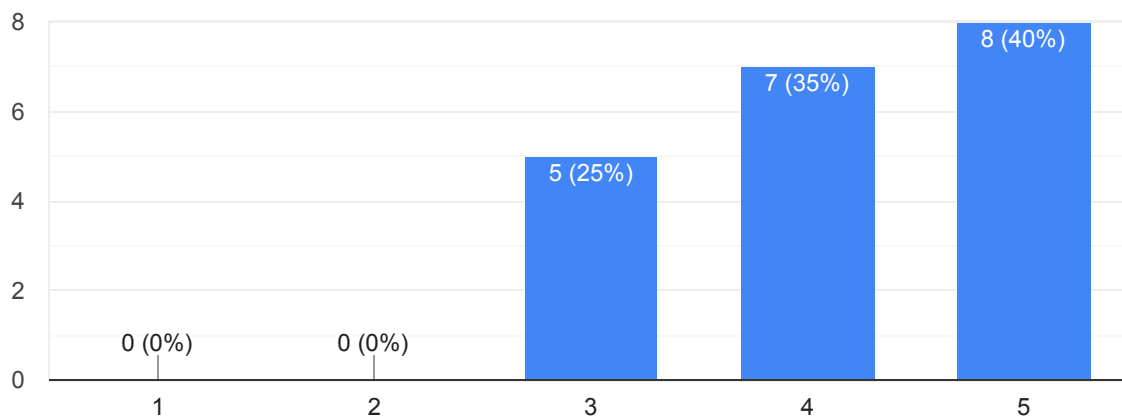

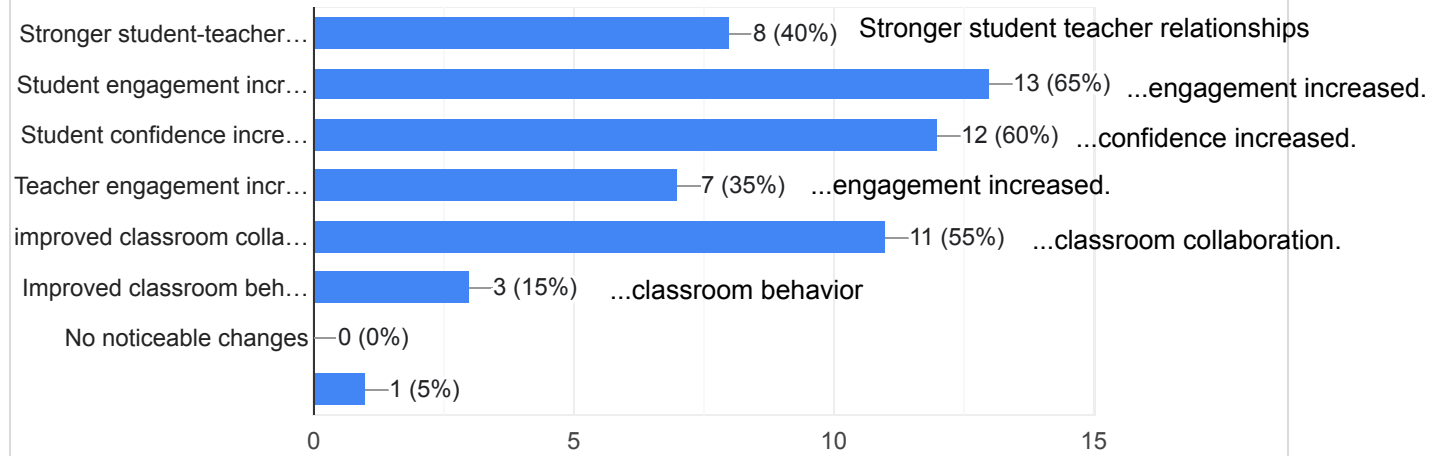
### Since participating in SMART, I have observed positive changes in my classroom culture.

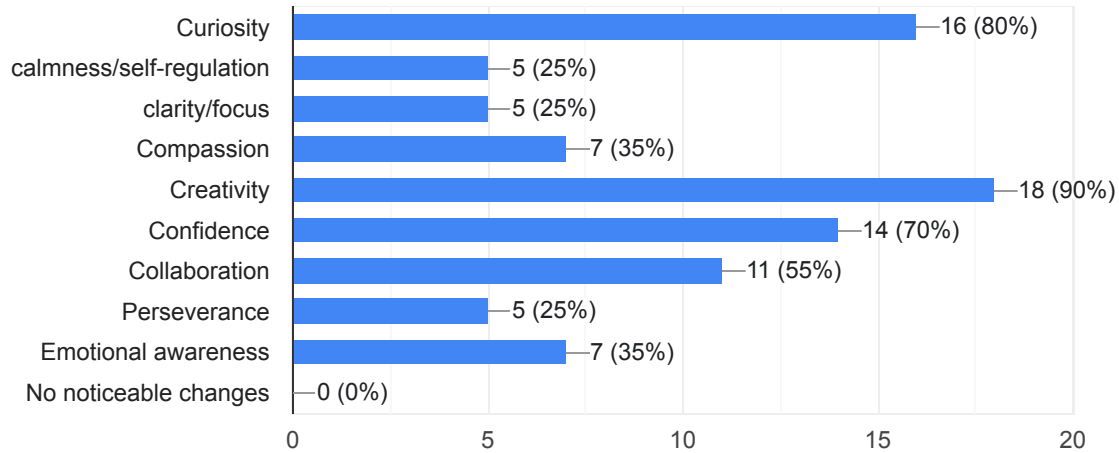
### Which classroom changes have you observed as a result of SMART? (select all that apply)

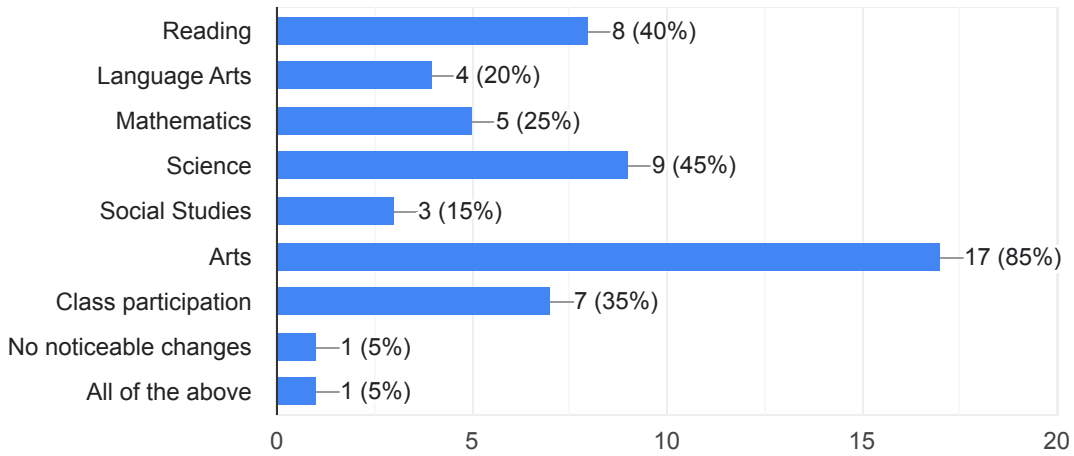

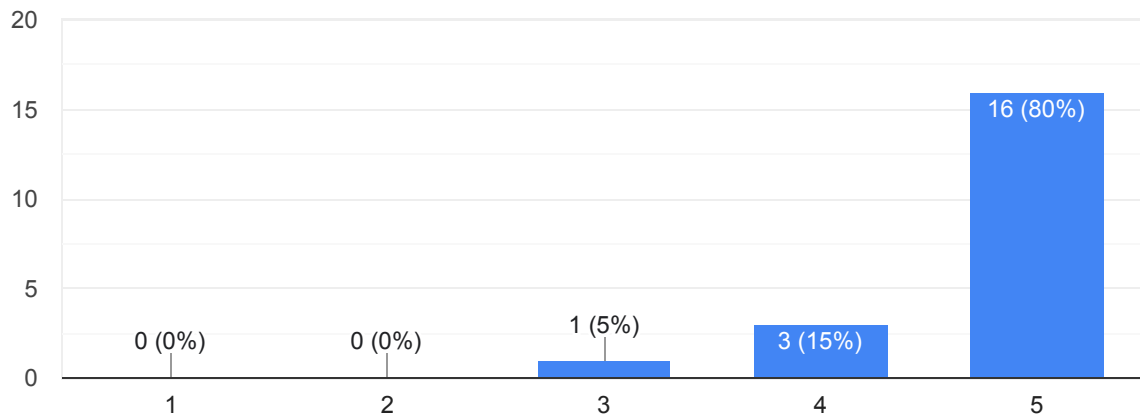

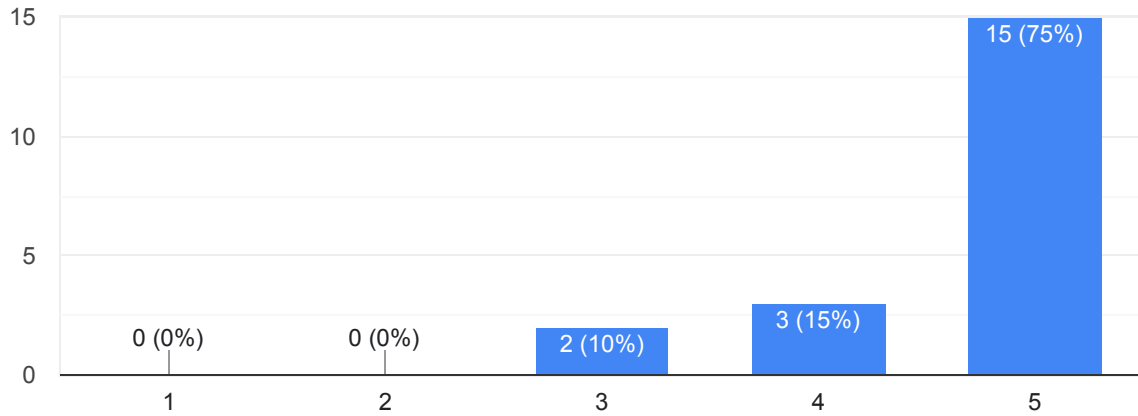

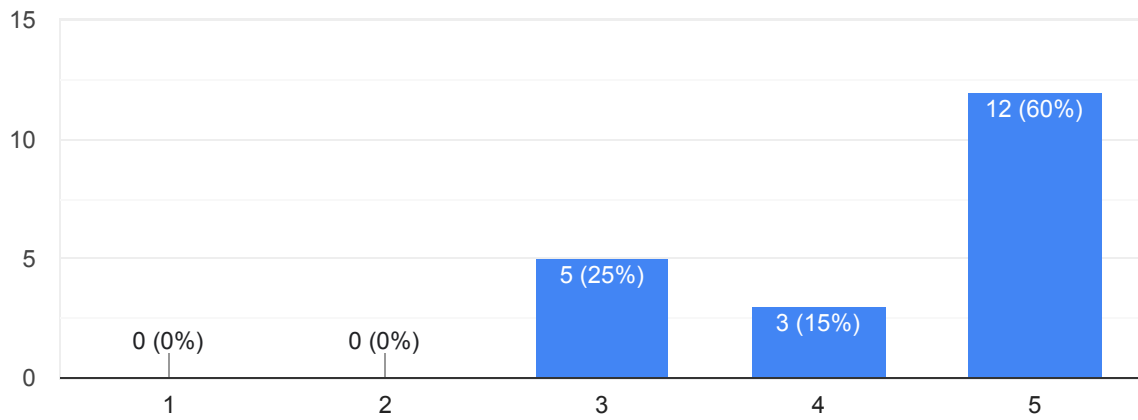
